FACILITATION OF THE DESIGN OF A NATIONAL NON-CLINICAL PATHWAY, WORKING WITH CLINICIANS, LIVED-EXPERIENCE ADVISORS, PROVIDERS, FUNDERS AND POLICY OFFICIALS.

THE WORK TESTED WHETHER THE PROPOSED PATHWAY WOULD SURVIVE CONTACT WITH THE SYSTEMS, THE WORKFORCE, THE FUNDING FLOWS AND THE FAMILIES IT WAS DESIGNED TO SERVE, AND SURFACED THE IMPLEMENTATION ASSUMPTIONS ON WHICH IT WOULD STAND OR FALL. ALSO INCLUDED A VALUE FOR MONEY ASSESSMENT.

THE PATHWAY IS NOW IN USE ACROSS THE RELEVANT SERVICES AND INFORMS THE WAY THE SYSTEM HOLDS WHĀNAU THROUGH ONE OF ITS HARDEST MOMENTS.

NATIONAL COMMISSIONING FRAMEWORK



DRAFTING OF A NATIONWIDE COMMISSIONING FRAMEWORK, INCLUDING THE PRINCIPLES, THE ARCHITECTURE, THE FUNDING LOGIC AND THE ASSURANCE MECHANISMS REQUIRED TO HOLD THE SYSTEM ACCOUNTABLE FOR OUTCOMES RATHER THAN FOR ACTIVITY.

THE WORK WAS PREPARED FOR THE COMMISSIONING AGENCY AND TESTED WITH CLINICAL AND CONSUMER ADVISORS BEFORE BEING PUT FORWARD FOR DECISION.

THE WORK ALSO INCLUDED STANDARDS, PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT SYSTEM AND ADVICE ON FUNDING PRINCIPLES.

INDEPENDENT QUALITY ASSURANCE REVIEW



AN INDEPENDENT QUALITY ASSURANCE REVIEW OF A LARGE DEFENCE INVESTMENT, TAKING A LONG LENS ACROSS TWENTY YEARS OF DECISIONS.

THE WORK EXAMINED THE RATIONALE, THE EVIDENCE BASE, THE ASSUMPTIONS AND THE ASSURANCE ARRANGEMENTS THAT HAD CARRIED THE INVESTMENT THROUGH SUCCESSIVE CABINET ROUNDS, IDENTIFIED WHERE THE CHAIN OF DECISION-MAKING HAD DRIFTED FROM THE ORIGINAL LOGIC, AND SET OUT WHAT WOULD NEED TO BE TRUE FOR THE NEXT DECISION TO STAND.

THE WORK WAS PROVIDED TO THE SPONSORING AGENCY AND THEN TO CABINET AS EVIDENCE FOR READINESS TO RECEIVE FUNDING TO UPGRADE SEVERAL BASES.

PEER REVIEW OF A WHĀNAU ORA REPORT AHEAD OF A CHANGE IN INVESTMENT LEVELS. A PEER REVIEW OF A WHĀNAU ORA REPORT BEING PREPARED AS THE EVIDENTIARY BASIS FOR A CHANGE IN INVESTMENT LEVELS.

THE WORK TESTED WHETHER THE ANALYSIS WOULD CARRY THE WEIGHT OF THE INVESTMENT DECISION, WHETHER THE EVIDENCE ON THE TABLE SUPPORTED THE PROPOSED SHIFT IN SCALE OR SHAPE, AND WHETHER THE ASSURANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY ARRANGEMENTS SET OUT IN THE REPORT WERE STRONG ENOUGH FOR THE LEVEL OF INVESTMENT BEING CONTEMPLATED.

FINDINGS WERE PROVIDED IN TIME FOR THE REPORT TO BE REVISED BEFORE IT WENT FORWARD FOR DECISION.

VRM AND READINESS REVIEW TO SHIFT POLICY DIRECTION



A REVIEW FOR VALUE FOR MONEY AND READINESS UNDERTAKEN AHEAD OF AN UPDATE TO THE GOVERNMENT POLICY STATEMENT ON ROAD POLICING.

THE WORK TESTED WHETHER THE EXISTING INVESTMENT WAS PRODUCING THE VALUE CLAIMED, WHETHER THE PROPOSED DIRECTION HAD THE IMPLEMENTATION ARCHITECTURE TO LAND IN PRACTICE, AND WHETHER THE GPS ITSELF WAS READY FOR MINISTERS AND THE OPERATIONAL AGENCY TO ACT ON.

THE REVIEW FED INTO THE GPS SETTINGS AND INTO THE NEXT INVESTMENT CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE CROWN, NZTA AND THE POLICE.
